### **Be Still**

"Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change, though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea...Be still, and know that I am God!" -Psalm 46:2&10a

I've recently spent a lot of time with families who have experienced rapid changes in a short period of time. Changes that cause a lot of grief. Changes that leave the future even more uncertain than it was already. I've gotten a lot of practice at being still. Sitting in moments of silence with these families because there is not a lot that can be said. Reading Scripture and praying, letting the Spirit speak for us.



Being still is incredibly hard! We want to give advice, give comfort, share our story, fix something with our hands, move past the grief and pain of change because it's uncomfortable. We also live in a world that doesn't want to give the time for stillness. There are things to do, mountains to climb, new experiences to have, and changes happening every minute. If we're not doing something...we're failing, lazy, inept, out of control, or not strong enough. Friends, that's simply not true.

"Be still" God invites us. "Remember that when all is said and done, my love for you will be all that's left" We can remember this without being still, but it can be easier if there is a stillness within us and around us. That stillness comes from God in Jesus Christ through the Spirit. It's not something you can make on your own but you can certainly cultivate it. How can you help bring the stillness of God to the world around you?







From Your Church Council President:

I thank God for this wonderful congregation. You are such caring, loving, and kind people.

I want to thank every one of you for contributing to such a wonderful service this last Sunday. Polka Spirit from Shiner was a wonderful joy to have lead our service. The baptism of Matthew was very touching. The potluck was fantastic. Thank all of you for bringing extra to make everyone feel welcome. Thanks for all the help in the kitchen. I invited several visitors who stayed for the potluck after I told them we had plenty of food. If you missed the service, I urge you to view it online either on Facebook or YouTube.

Don Kennedy has gotten a roofer to fix the leak in the bell tower and the window in the sanctuary. We have been putting up a tarp after service over the altar to protect it from the leakage. The cost is \$4,200 for the repair. The church council voted to use memorial funds to pay for the repair.\* We have over \$20,000 in that fund and much of it has been in there for years. You have been giving generously to the church, so we felt that we did not want to ask you to come up with any extra money.
